MATERIALS/CUTTING INFO: you will need to trim kit pieces to these sizes:


SEWING INSTRUCTIONS: Reminder: use scant ¼" seams for accuracy!

Center star unit:



1	Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the eight COLOR C 2" squares. Put one COLOR C square and one COLOR D 2x 3 ½ " rectangle right sides together as shown. Sew ON the drawn diagonal line.	
2	Trim seam to ¼". Press seam away from rectangle.	
3	Repeat steps 1 and 2 on opposite side of rectangle (be sure that your diagonal seam is angled correctly!)	
4	Repeat steps 1-3 to create four small flying geese units.	
5	Lay out the 3 ½ color E center square, four 2" COLOR D squares, and Flying Geese COLOR C/D units as shown. Sew two flying geese to opposite sides of center square; sew corner patches to opposite sides of remaining geese units, then sew rows together.	

Outer Flying Geese Units;

1	Cut the COLOR A 7 ¼" square across both diagonals to create four smaller triangles. Cut the COLOR B 3 7/8" squares in half diagonally to create 8 triangles.	
2	Join the left hand triangle (COLOR B) to the larger COLOR A background triangle. Match points and bottom edges; sew in the direction of the arrow. Press seam allowances toward the smaller triangle.	

3	Join the left hand triangle (COLOR B) to the larger COLOR A background triangle. Match points and bottom edges; sew in the direction of the arrow. Press seam allowances toward the smaller triangle.	
4	Repeat steps 1-3 to create four large outer flying geese units.	

Block Assembly:

1	Sew the 3 ½" COLOR A squares to opposite sides of the two outer flying geese units.	
2	Sew the remaining two flying geese units to opposite sides of the center star unit.	
3	Attach top and bottom rows to the center unit. <b>Block should be 12 ½" square!!!</b> Do not trim!
